Description

The Portuguese Refugee Council (CPR) is a non-profit, independent and pluralistic Non-Governmental Organization for Development (NGOD), inspired by a humanist culture of tolerance and respect for the dignity of other peoples. With a long-standing experience in managing EU and National Funds, CPR, founded in 1991, runs three reception centres for refugees in Portugal, one of them dedicated to the support of unaccompanied refugee minors. CPR is a wellestablished organization with over six dozen staff members. it operates several ongoing projects funded by several entities, aiming at refugee integration and promotion of humanitarian and sustainable asylum policies, training and awareness-raising of this issue and human rights in general. CPR's role is defined in the Portuguese Asylum Act, where it is mentioned a intrinsically linked to UNHCR's action in Portugal. The Law provides UNHCR/CPR the right to be informed of all asylum claims presented in Portugal, the right to personally contact all asylum seekers irrespective of the place of presentation in order to provide information on the asylum procedure as well as its intervention throughout the process, and the right to be informed of all procedural steps and acts which depends on the claimant's consent. CPR also seeks to raise public awareness and mainstream refugee rights into public debate for a more inclusive society notably through advocacy initiatives (conferences, seminars, training courses). CPR was awarded with the "Human Rights Award" of the Portuguese Parliament, in 2000. Currently, CPR has a team of 63 paid staff, working full time in the organization.
