

F PARIS005: Information for exchange students 2019-2020

ERASMUS+ AND NON-ERASMUS+ PARTNERSHIPS

Dear partners,

We would like to remind you the process of exchange students' admission at Paris Descartes University for the first semester and the entire academic year.

Step 1- Eramus+ nominations

Please nominate

- before May 15th 2019 your selected students.

Nominations have to be made by email and send directly to the concerned host faculty.

Step 2- Application

- until May 31st 2019.

After having officially nominated your outgoing students, they will first receive an email of information/confirmation in order to apply for their mobility: they will have to fill out, print and sign the online application form ("formulaire de candidature en ligne").

The following official documents have to be sent to the corresponding host faculty of Paris Descartes University:

- The online application form signed by the student and the home university
- The Erasmus+ Learning or placement agreement/Learning or placement agreement
- We remind you that we will not accept students with a learning agreement of less than 30 ECTS for 1 semester exchange and less than 60 ECTS for 1-year exchange.
- A copy of the transcript showing the academic level courses completed
- A proof of French level: students are asked to provide proof of a B2 level at the TCF/TEF French tests or at the DELF
- A copy of their ID card /passport
- A copy of their student card

Step 3- Housing and welcome week application

Welcome week application form and housing application form are gathered on the same platform. Nevertheless, they are two distinct applications! Applying for one of them does not mean that it is an application for both.

Housing:

Please inform your students applying for a housing that only the online application will be taken into account and that accommodation cannot be guaranteed.

Welcome week or "SILC" (Stage Intensif en Langue et Civilisation française):

Welcome week application consists in an online language test in order to split the participants into level groups.

(Key of the language test: MOBILITYP5)
