Accommodation

Karlshöhe Ludwigsburg: There are shared flats for students which are located close to the campus as well as inclusive shared flats with either elders or people with impairments. Health Insurance	Incoming students are asked to send a copy of their EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) to the International Office (mail: io@eh-ludwigsburg.de)
Banking	Students should open a bank account because in Germany rent is paid through a bank account. The account is usually free of charge for students.
